Langport Cemetery

Price List

(agreed at Full Council Meeting on 17th September 2024)

It is possible to arrange a full interment in the Cemetery or an interment of ashes in the Garden of Rest, or an existing grave, but Langport Town Council retains all rights to the Cemetery land.

Burial rights, which are granted for a period of **100 years**, must be purchased for all interment plots and the appropriate fees paid to Langport Town Council. It is possible to purchase, in advance, a burial plot for future use and each grave can accommodate up to a maximum of two full interments and three ashes interments.

Memorials may be placed on graves, where burial rights have been purchased, but not before permission has been received from Langport Town Council and the appropriate fee paid.

The Town Council doesn't carry out any work related to the excavation of burial plots, all work being co-ordinated by third parties, normally local Undertakers firms.

PLEASE NOTE:

1. The fees quoted for monuments, gravestones, and tablets include the first inscription. Each additional inscription will incur a charge of £45.00
2. Only tablets laid flat on the ground are allowed in the Garden of Rest.
3. Headstones and Ashes Interment Tablets may include an oval photograph of the deceased, provided that this does not exceed 100mm in height and 75mm in width at its widest points. Photographs are not permitted on Flat Stones, Footstones, Movable Vases, Kerb Sets or any other monument.
