Licensing Objectives

a) General, all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) The premises will operate primarily as a boutique retail shop selling skincare, homeware and selected premium local alcoholic products. The business is intended to provide a calm, design led retail environment. Staff will be trained and procedures followed to prevent sales of alcohol to underage customers, expanded below,

b) The prevention of crime and disorder Alcohol sales to be monitored by trained staff with a Challenge 25 policy in place. Alcohol to be positioned in clear sight of the till. Staff to be trained regarding underage sales and acceptable forms of identification and to maintain a refusals register. We will have CCTV installed covering the entrance, till area and alcohol display. Any incidents of disorder of theft to be recorded and managed appropriately.

c) Public safety	The premises will maintain a clear fire exit and unobstructed walk ways. Fire equipment to be maintained and regularly checked. Shop occupancy will remain suitable for the size. Staff to be aware of emergency procedures. Displays to be arranged safely to avoid trip hazards and premises kept clean and well lit.
d) The prevention of public nuisance	Opening hours are appropriate and in line with the area. Low music levels. The shop is intended as a calm retail environment .
e) The protection of children from harm	A challenge 25 policy will be operated with anyone who looks under 25 to be asked for suitable identification for proof of age. Staff will be trained on this. Children will remain supervised with accompanying adults. Alcohol products to be displayed responsibly in the shop.
